Nekyia in ancient greece is a rite by which ghosts were called up and questioned about the future. it is also the story of odysseus's journey to hades, where he meets and talks to the souls of the dead. the project Nekyia consists of 6 monologues of greek heroines: 4 vocal monologues - alcestis, alexandra, epicasta, euridice and 2 choreographic monologues - philomela and procne. the vocal monologues can be performed live (by four voices) or in a four-channel recording. the choreographic monologues are performed live. the vocal/choreographic performance is combined with the video projection by Elena Nemkova.
